



COOPERATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
ZAMBIA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY
AND
SEYCHELLES CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AND
INDUSTRY

With the desire to promote the development of trade and economic relations between Zambia and Seychelles and taking into consideration the similarity of the objectives in terms of promoting trade, industry and investment, representing the interests of their respective business communities, the Zambia Chamber of Commerce and Industry and the Seychelles Chamber Of Commerce and Industry hereinafter referred to as "The Parties", have agreed to the following, on the basis of equality and mutual benefit:

Article 1

The Parties undertake to exchange and disseminate information and publications with regard to trade, technical transfer, economic cooperation, trade fairs, exhibitions, policies, economic legislation pertaining to the foreign trade of the two countries.

Article 2

The Parties shall develop relationships and promote contacts between industrialists, and entrepreneurs of both countries.

Article 3

The Parties shall recommend and introduce to each other trade investment opportunities for cooperation, encourage and assist their members to cooperate with their counterparts in the form of joint ventures, production cooperation, technology transfer or other forms.

Article 4

The Parties will identify consultancy services, where necessary, within their respective business scope and provide each other with a list of consultant members and their specific expertise.

Article 5

The Parties will cooperate to assist their members, in exchange of trade missions, project study groups, encouraging and supporting the mutual participation of their member companies in industrial and trade exhibitions as mutual agreed.

Article 6

The Parties shall cooperate in organizing workshops, seminars on cooperation projects, exhibitions, conferences, technical seminars, and displays of the samples and literature of new products as mutually agreed.

Article 7

The Parties shall act as promoters in order to develop trade and economic activities between Zambia and Seychelles.

Article 8

The parties, within their competence, will endeavor in full co-operation with each other and to their mutual advantages, to take steps that may

contribute to the strengthening and development of the present cooperation agreement.

Article 9

The Parties cover their own respective expenses on international travel, boarding, lodging and transportation during the visit with regard to mission. The expenses for the activities listed in Article 1 to Article 8 will be borne in principle by the sponsoring Authority while the other side will provide appropriate assistance.


Article 10

The agreement shall come into force on the date of its signing by the Parties and will remain valid for an indefinite period, till one of the Parties gives the other party a one month written notice of its intention to terminate it.
